### 1-year-old class

1-year-old classes emphasize social interaction and playful preschool introduction.

Designed to foster social and emotional growth in children.

Engage in age-appropriate crafts and introduce fundamental concepts like letters, numbers, colors, and shapes. Follow a structured schedule allowing plenty of playtime.

**Encourage smooth transitions between activities and locations on campus.** 









### 2-year-old class

We aim to introduce 2-year-olds to a vibrant learning environment beyond their homes.

Creating a secure, nurturing, and joyful setting for free exploration, play, and learning.

New elements like colors, numbers, shapes, themes, and letters each month for an engaging experience.

Story reading, lively songs, fun dances, and group play encourage active participation and reinforce learning.

Art projects creatively reinforce and solidify understanding of introduced concepts, sparking enthusiasm and creativity.





### 3-year-old class

The 3-year-old classes offer an academically-focused, socially interactive, and nurturing environment, fostering cognitive, social, physical, and spiritual growth.

The 4-hour program includes Free Play, Circle Time, Art, and Guided Learning Centers, along with weekly sessions in Science, Music, and Chapel.

We Implement "ZOOPHONICS" for diverse learning styles while encouraging free play alongside weekly themed activities covering varied topics.



Aims to develop cognitive, language, math, motor, and social skills, preparing children for Pre-K.











### Pre-K /Transitional Kindergarten (TK) year-old classes

Focuses on Kindergarten readiness and age-appropriate skill development.

Emphasizes both tangible skills (like letter recognition, formation, and sounds) and intangible skills (being a good friend, following directions, independence).

Utilizes various educational tools, crafts, and science materials to make learning enjoyable.

Maintains small class sizes with an 8-1 student to teacher ratio, allowing for individualized and differentiated teaching.

We are a Christ-centered school and that shows in our curriculum.

Partners closely with families to instill a love of learning and often maintains lasting relationships with students and families.

Includes recess, snack time, lunch, science, music, and chapel attendance while ensuring time for family activities or playdates after school.

Our numbers are small, 8-1 student to teacher ratio so the teaching is differentiated and individual.
